consequences

- ◆ Forfeit God's fellowship. (Psa. 15:3)
- ◆ Invite God's wrath. (Psa. 101:5; 1 Tim. 1:10)
- ◆ Ruin your relationships. (Prov. 11:13)
- ◆ Witness against yourself. (2 Tim. 3:3)
- ◆ Exalt yourself over God. (James 4:11)

A **false** witness. (53-59)

evidences

- ♦ Judgment made before facts known
- ♦ Sentence passed before witnesses examined
- ♦ “I heard/saw” = “I was told”
- ♦ Details don’t line up
